
Remains of liyama Castle liyama Castle, located in the heart of the city, was constructed under the order of Kenshin Uesugi, who used this castle as a retreat base during the Battle of Kawanakajima. The castle was built in a staircase fashion, which made it possible to withhold attacks from Shingen Takeda in the 12 years of battle. In spring, the castle site is famous for the 400 Cherry Blossom Trees (Someivoshino variety) which bloom all at once.
