Access to Mount Fuji



- 1 Kumano Kodo Iseji Route / Mie ▶B-6**
The ancient pilgrimage trails link two locations, Ise and Kumano.
- 2 Fujisan (Mount Fuji) / Shizuoka ▶E-4**
Japan's highest mountain with an altitude of 3,776 meters (12,390 feet), recognized as a symbol of Japan.
- 3 Historical Villages of Shirakawa-go / Gifu ▶C-2**
Different scenic elegance can be enjoyed for each season. A light-up event is held in winter.

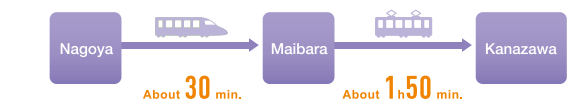

- 4 Soba of Shinshu / Nagano ▶D-2**
Soba or buckwheat noodles are cooked and served hot or cold and are enjoyed in various styles.
- 5 Echizen-gani (Crab) / Fukui ▶B-3**
The prime crabs presented to the Imperial Family.
- 6 Top quality Japanese beef / Mie, Shiga, Gifu ▶C-5 B-4 C-3**
Matsusaka Beef, Omi Beef, and Hida Beef are true works of art.
- 7 Japanese confectionery / Ishikawa ▶C-2**
A variety of Japanese cakes and sweets with elegant taste and beauty.
- 8 "Kabayaki" eel / Shizuoka ▶D-5**
Well-developed muscles, sufficient fat, and texture that melts in the mouth are the distinctive features of broiled eel in Shizuoka.
- 9 Local sake, jizake / Nagano ▶D-3**
Jizake or local sake is a genre of sake produced using traditional brewing methods cultivated and handed down in the region.

- 10 Kamezaki Shiohi Matsuri / Aichi ▶C-5**
In this magnificent and lively festival, five dynamic floats move in the low-tide shore.
- 11 Higashi Chaya District / Ishikawa ▶C-2**
One of Kanazawa's famous chaya or teahouse districts where a historical townscape with rows of latticed houses still remains.
- 12 Seki Sword Tradition Museum / Gifu ▶C-4**
Exhibition of real Japanese swords is available for visitors and observation of traditional Japanese sword forging is open to the public on certain designated days.

Natural Hot Springs

- 13 Gero Hot Spring / Gifu ▶C-3**
One of the Japan's three great hot springs, with over 1,000 years of history.
- 14 Toba Hot Spring / Mie ▶C-5**
Located in a wonderful location with open feeling and excellent seafood.
- 15 Jigokudani Snow Monkeys / Nagano ▶E-2**
Wild Japanese macaques, the world-famous snow monkeys, bathe in their special outdoor hot spring.
- 16 Nagashima Hot Spring / Mie ▶G**
This Japan's largest-scale hot spring leisure land features many outdoor and indoor hot springs.

About 450 carp streamers swim by the estuaries of the Otani River.

Sweet shrimp / Ishikawa ▶C-2
Characterized by the melting sweetness, sweet shrimps arrive in stores as sashimi and sushi.

Girls' Festival and hina dolls / Shiga ▶B-4
Showcase of many hina dolls dressed in the local specialty Omi-jofu, finely woven hemp fabric.

Tonami Tulip Park / Toyama ▶C-2
One million tulips are in full bloom in multiple colors during the tulip fair.

Oigawa Railway SL Trains / Shizuoka ▶D-4

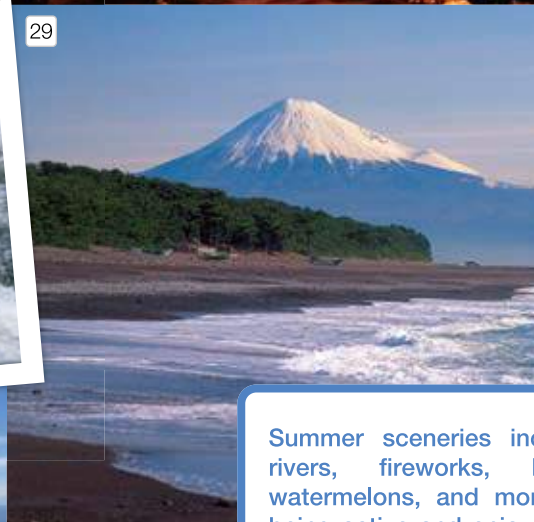

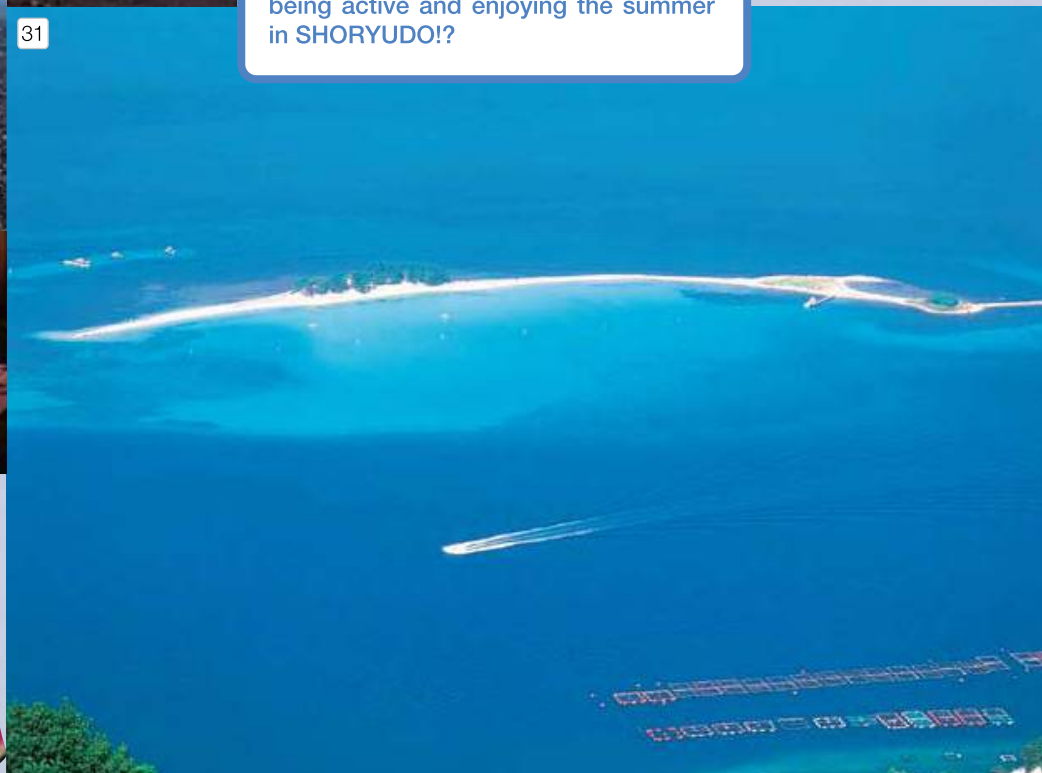

Kumano Grand Fireworks Festival / Mie ▶B-6
A fireworks festival, with more than 300 years of honored tradition, held as the first memorial service of the deceased souls during Obon.

Rafting / Gifu ▶C-3
Dynamic rafting experience of going downstream on the Nagara River.

Mizushima Island (Hawaii of the Hokuriku) / Fukui ▶B-3
This uninhabited island located just five minutes away by ferry is also referred to as "Hawaii of the Hokuriku region."

Japan's traditional fishing technique "Ukai" / Aichi, Gifu ▶C-4
Japan's traditional comorant fishing technique is called "ukai" in which comorant fishing masters manipulate Japanese comorants to catch ayu or sweetfish.

Miho no Matsubara (Pine wood at Miho) / Shizuoka ▶E-5
Counted as one of Japan's three great pine groves, more than 30,000 pine trees stretch 7 kilometers on the shoreline.

32

Owara Kaze-no-Bon Festival / Toyama ▶C-2
This folk festival is held in the nostalgic townscape of stone paved streets and dancers gracefully dance with the melancholic melody.

Tojinbo / Fukui ▶B-2
The sheer precipices of the world's rare oddly-shaped rocks provide a thrilling view.

Lake Biwa / Shiga ▶B-4
The largest in Japan and the third oldest lake in the world (with four million years of history).

Fukui Suika (watermelon) / Fukui ▶B-3
The watermelon from Fukui is highly rated for the fresh, crisp texture and rich sweetness.

34 Fresh mushrooms / Nagano ▶D-2

A variety of high quality and highly nutritious mushrooms can be savored throughout the year.

37 Shigaraki Ware / Shiga ▶B-5

One of Japan's oldest six potteries which is famous for a wide variety of ceramic raccoon dogs.

40 Mitsuke Tenjin Hadaka (Naked) Festival / Shizuoka ▶D-5

A festival designated as an Important Intangible Folk Cultural Property in which the ways of the ancients still remain strong.

35 Higashi Park / Aichi ▶G

This natural and cultural park has a shaka-do, stone monuments inscribed with tanka poems, etc.

38 Hyozu Taisha Shrine / Shiga ▶B-4

The illumination is held in autumn, adding elegance to the shrine's landscape garden.

41 Fuyu Persimmon / Gifu ▶C-4

Very juicy, sweet, and soft as if it melts in the mouth are the distinctive features.

36 Ishiyamadera Temple / Shiga ▶B-5

Various flowers bloom season by season and the temple is also referred to as the "temple of flowers."

39 Kurobe Gorge Railway / Toyama ▶D-2

The beautiful scenery of foliage can be enjoyed in Japan's deepest V-shape gorge.

42 Shiga Highland Ski Resort / Nagano ▶E-2

A large ski resort where all skiers from beginners to advanced skiers can have fun.

45 Historical Villages of Gokayama / Toyama ▶C-2

The illumination is held in winter and a dreamy snow scape can be enjoyed.

48 Winter Illumination (Nabana no Sato) / Mie ▶G

The warm illumination envelops everything around it including your heart.

43 Kenroku-en (Garden) / Ishikawa ▶C-2

Notable for "yukitsuri" or ropes attached to trees and branches to prevent them from breaking caused by heavy snow.

46 Okuhida Hot Spring Village / Gifu ▶D-3

A village of the Northern Alps, the roof of Japan, and open-air hot springs.

49 Tateyama Tamadono-no-Yusui / Toyama ▶D-2

Quality natural spring water selected as one of the Japan's 100 Exquisite and Well-conserved Waters and enjoyed by mountain climbers and tourists.

44 Dosojin Fire Festival in Nozawa Hot Spring / Nagano ▶E-1

With the 300-year history, this festival is counted as one of the three major fire festivals in Japan.

47 Three-storied Pagoda at Myotsuji Temple / Fukui ▶B-4

The Hondo constructed back in the Kamakura period and the three-storied pagoda that stands approx. 22 meters (72 feet) high are both National Treasures.

50 Miso-nikomi Udon / Aichi ▶G

Rich fragrance of miso broth and al dente noodles are the distinctive features of this flavorful udon or wheat flour noodle dish.
